# The Lord Saw Her

Have you ever wondered if you mattered to God? The psalmist asks, "Who are we that you are aware of us? Who are we that you care for us?" (Psalm 8.4)

In the Gospel Lesson for this week (Luke 7.11-17) we have this answer to that question -- "the Lord saw her..." She wasn't lost in the crowd – she was the center of Jesus' attention. She was a widow – and she was on the way to bury her only son. We can just imagine how lonely and lost she felt. First, her husband – then her son – now the grief! Now the lostness – the emptiness – the nothingness . . .

We can only imagine how she must have prayed as she held her sick and dying child. Oh, God – please . . .not again . . . please . . .let my son live . . . please . . .

Until her son went limp in her arms -- "Who are we that you are aware of us? Who are we that you care for us?" Nobody – I am a nobody! God doesn't know who I am. God doesn't

care for me! My son is dead.

She had entered the world of the walking dead – going through the motions – doing what had to be done. Walking in her son's funeral procession – one step at a time – one foot in front of another – hardly able to stand up -- so weak from the grief – unaware of anything or anyone around her . . .

Then -- "the Lord saw her..."
She was no longer lost in the crowd – she was in the sight of Jesus – and his heart overflowed with compassion for her. Jesus was so deeply moved by her plight that he went to her and spoke to her – "Don't weep!"

"Don't weep!" "Don't weep!"
Who would say such a thing to a person so deep in grief?
What person so deep in grief would be able to hear, "Don't weep!"? But Jesus wasn't full of empty words -- his words were the beginning of mercy -- the foreshadowing of grace.
Jesus moved to the coffin – touched it – and said, "Young man, get up!" And he did!

Prayers answered – at last! Mercy! Grace! Joy!

Jesus' compassion for the widow turns the day inside out – brings good news out of despair – tells everyone – God cares! God even cares for the walking dead widow. God even cares for the stone dead son. God even cares for those who ever wondered . . . . . does God care . . . about me?

The Message tells us "the crowd realized they were in a place of holy mystery that God

was at work among them.
They were quietly worshipful
– and then noisily grateful,
calling out among themselves, 'God is back, looking
to the needs of his people!"
Now our Good News – God
sees us – just as Jesus saw
the widow -- God sees us!

I hope to see you Sunday so we can be worshipful and grateful together!




